What is applied Energistics 2?

The main feature of Applied Energistics 2 is the ME Network(pronounced Emm- Eee and stands for Matter Energy), which is a set of connected blocks, and cables grouped into a system, where storage, power and functions cooperate between multiple components.

The ME Interface is a block added by Applied Energistics 2 and Applied Energistics mods. It allows the ME Network to interact with machines, transport pipes and tubes. The ME Security Terminal is a block added by the Applied Energistics 2 mod. It is used to set security measures restricting access to the ME Network and to synchronise the Wireless Terminal.On a multi-player server a Biometric Card with a given level of access can be set for each user. However the Security Terminal cannot prevent vandalism to the devices and cables ...

The ME Auto Crafting system is an expandable modular multi-block structure from the Applied Energistics 2 mod. An important feature of the ME Network.Once properly set-up the Player only need to order the items needed on demand by creating a crafting job and the system will automatically craft all needed parts from the resources available.

The ME Storage Bus, when attached to another inventory block in the world lets you access that inventory via networked functions. This allows you to use chests, barrels, or other types of item storage in your networks. The storage via the ME Storage Bus is bi-directional, it can both insert, or extract items from the inventory block it is attached to as long as the ME Storage Bus has its ...

The Energy Cell is a block added by the Applied Energistics 2 mod. Designed to Store AE units, it is used to craft powered ME Network devices, weapons and tools. It can store up to 200 kAE and may be charged by connecting it to the Network where it ...

To set up a networking there are only a few things needed: exactly one ME Controller (it won"t work if you have more) a power source connected to your Controller at least one Storage Block (ME Drive or ME Chest) The following are rather optional one ME Access Terminal or ME Crafting Terminal if you have chosen an ME Drive as your first Storage Block some ME Cable to ...

Tunnels are 1 input to N outputs. This means you can output to as many points as you want, but only input at a single point per tunnel.

The AE2 "SSD" is a good example, though kind of overshadows the core mechanic by adding in easier (though slightly confusing) access to the Storage Cells themselves.

The ME Dense Cable is the only cable that can support 32 channel simultaneously so it can be used as a main data line to connect to another ME Controller or branch off into 8 channel distribution lines via ...
