

Cancel request system power off

What is the difference between request system halt & request system power off?

Request system halt = Halt the system & Request system power off= Power off the software on RE *Halt terminates all processes and shut down the CPU. *Power off is same like halt, but it also turns off the unit itself (lights and everything on PC)

How to turn off power switch without halt command?

Turning off power-switch without giving "request system halt" command, If the power is switched off during a write, the file system could be corrupted. Graceful shutdown done using "request system halt" Halt stops the OS and then we can proceed with powering down the device after halting. power off not only shuts down software but also hardware.

What happens if a power halt is performed using cli 'request system power-off'?

When manual power halt of the device is performed using CLI "request system power-off" with physical power drain of the device, a different "last reboot reason" is reported. If the command "request system power-off" is issued, and no power is drained, the switch will report a normal shutdown. Slot 0: Current state Master

What happens if I enter a power-off command?

When you enter this command, you are provided feedback on the status of your request. user@host> request system power-off message "This router will be powered off in 30 minutes. Please save your data and log out immediately." warning: This command will not halt the other routing-engine.

Can a re go offline if a system is halted?

If you use "power-off" though, it appears the RE actually powers itself down. Booting the RE after that requires having someone physically power cycle the chassis. Note that for both EX8200 and MX960, the line cards do NOT go offline immediately when the system is halted. They have to eventually time out before they finally go offline.

How do I power off srx3k / srx1k?

Per PR880619, the "power-off" CLI is enhanced to trigger the shutdown process of the hardware component. Press and hold the power button (SRX3K - SFB card / SRX1K - SYSIOC card). The power button stops the system software and powers off the chassis.

If I issue the command "request system power-off" or "request system halt", the system stops, but I do not get the prompt "hit any key to restart" like I do on other EX series switches. The only way to restart the switch appears to be pulling the power cords out and putting them back in. Is there anyway to remote restart an EX4600 switch? #EX4600

On an EX2200-C running Junos 15.1R5.5, issuing a "request system power-off in 0" did result in the switch performing a graceful shutdown and as u/turbov6camaro noted, after the ...

Power-off the backup RE with the command: `request system power-off other-routing-engine` . For example, while you are logged in to RE1, which is the primary, the backup RE0 is powered off: `user@host> request system power-off other-routing-engine`. Verify that the RE is powered-off with the command: `show chassis routing-engine` .

Hi Aqeel,. For VM Hosted devices, the request system power-off command is replaced with the request vmhost power-off command which provides similar functionality.. Juniper states: "For the devices with Routing Engines RE-S-2x00x6, RE-PTX-2x00x8, and RE-S-2x00x8, this command is deprecated and might be removed completely in a future release."

The difference between "Request system halt" and "request system power-off" is that the "request system power-off" command safely shuts down the operating system, but it goes a step further by physically powering off the device. The system is fully turned off, and no manual intervention is needed to remove power. ...
