Fix that cloudy plastic covering the solar cells by coating it with a thin layer of clear nail polish or a spray-on clear lacquer. These clear coatings render the plastic clear once again. Cover the areas surrounding the plastic -- either the housing for the cells or the lid of a light with a built-in solar panel -- with painter's tape before applying the chosen clear-coat material.

Sponges are great products to clean solar panels with because they won't scratch. If deciding to use a little bit of soap on your sponge, use something that you might clean your dishes with. Laundry detergents and other stronger chemicals might interact with your solar panels in a negative way.

Although solar panels and lights don't require frequent touch-up, occasionally cleaning the solar lights will maintain their illumination. For this, you need to clean the solar lights, panel, cover, and batteries to get back the brightness. A damp cloth, a soft brush, and dish soap will be enough to remove the dirt covering the lighting system.

In general, batteries in outdoor solar lights last 3 to 4 years before needing replacement. Some manufacturers sell replacement batteries, while others require you to buy an entirely new fixture. You can help increase your solar lights' life span by cleaning the panels regularly and protecting them from harsh winter weather.
