

Where can compressed air energy be stored?

The number of sites available for compressed air energy storage is higher compared to those of pumped hydro [1]. Porous rocks and cavern reservoirs are also ideal storage sites for CAES. Gas storage locations are capable of being used as sites for storage of compressed air.

What is compressed air energy storage?

Compressed air energy storage (CAES) is one of the many energy storage options that can store electric energy in the form of potential energy (compressed air) and can be deployed near central power plants or distribution centers. In response to demand, the stored energy can be discharged by expanding the stored air with a turboexpander generator.

Can gas storage locations be used for compressed air storage?

Gas storage locations are capable of being used as sites for storage of compressed air. Today, several research activities are being carried out to explore the application of CAES on small scale projects, following their successful integration on large scale renewable energy systems [2].

Where is compressed air stored?

Compressed air is stored in underground caverns or up ground vessels. The CAES technology has existed for more than four decades. However, only Germany (Huntorf CAES plant) and the United States (McIntosh CAES plant) operate full-scale CAES systems, which are conventional CAES systems that use fuel in operation [3].

What is a compressed air storage system?

The compressed air storages built above the ground are designed from steel. These types of storage systems can be installed everywhere, and they also tend to produce a higher energy density. The initial capital cost for above- the-ground storage systems are very high.

How many kW can a compressed air energy storage system produce?

CAES systems are categorised into large-scale compressed air energy storage systems and small-scale CAES. The large-scale is capable of producing more than 100MW, while the small-scale only produce less than 10 kW. The small-scale produces energy between 10 kW - 100MW [4].

What is Compressed Air Energy Storage (CAES)? Compressed Air Energy Storage is a technology that stores energy by using electricity to compress air and store it in large underground caverns or tanks. When energy is needed, the compressed air is released, expanded, and heated to drive a turbine, which generates electricity.
