



# Cost of a residential solar power system

How much does a solar panel cost?

Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.75 per watt, putting the price of a 400-watt panel at \$300. The cost of a solar panel also depends on how you buy it. If you purchase through a full-service installer, you will likely get a lower price for each panel than buying them individually from a retail store.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210 before considering any financial incentives. However, a typical American household needs a system closer to 10 kW to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2024. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

How much energy does a solar system cost?

Before solar, this represents the average utility rate over the next 20 years, assuming annual rate hikes between 3-5% (based on location). After solar, this is essentially your lifetime energy cost divided by the total production of your system. Here's how that looks for the example system above:  $\$45,102 / 242,483 \text{ kWh} = 18.6 \text{ kWh}$

How much does solar installation cost?

Installation labor accounts for around 5.5% of the total cost of a residential solar project, according to a 2022 report from the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. That amounts to \$1,375 for a \$25,000 solar project.

What is a residential solar installation?

In a residential solar installation, solar panels use photovoltaic cells (PV) that collect and convert the sun's energy into usable electricity to power a home. Solar power can offer significant cost savings over time by reducing monthly electricity bills or eliminating them entirely depending on household energy needs.

For example, the cost of solar panels for a 2,500 square foot home would be \$28,750 before incentives and \$20,125 after the 30% tax credit.  $2,500 \times \$11.50 = \$28,750$ . While this method provides a quick-and-dirty estimate for the cost of solar panels, solar systems are sized based on electricity consumption -- not the size of your home.

As of January 2022, the average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$2.77 per watt (\$27,700 for a 10-kilowatt system). That means the cost for a 10 kW solar system would be \$20,498 after the federal tax credit discount (not factoring in any additional state rebates or incentives).. In terms of cost, polycrystalline panels are a much more affordable option, totaling approximately \$0.95/W. A 6kW solar system composed of these panels will cost at least \$2,000 less than a monocrystalline version. Finally, there are thin-film solar panels, which have the worst efficiency rating of the group at 12%.

With solar panels priced between \$2.40 and \$3.60 per watt, the total cost of your system rises in proportion to the energy it must generate. Type of Panels. The selection of solar panels affects the material costs of your solar system, ranging from \$0.90 to \$1.50 per watt.

So a 5kW system would cost around \$25,000-\$35,000 before rebates. While that cost is a stiff pill for many households to swallow, it's common for utility companies to offer incentives or subsidies to offset solar system costs. For example, a system that costs \$18,000 has a payback period of about 20 years.

This massive drop in the prices of solar panels and other system components makes solar power more affordable than ever. A solar investment is now achievable for many, not just a few. Back in 2008, a standard 3 kW solar power system cost around \$40,000. In 2024, the price tag of a 3 kW solar power system is approximately \$9,000\* (completely ...
