



# Does home depot take lithium batteries

Can you recycle batteries at Home Depot?

Here are some options for recycling: The Home Depot Store has partnered with Call2Recycle, a nonprofit battery recycling program. Rechargeable batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Any rechargeable battery that weighs up to 11 pounds and is under 300 watt hours is accepted. There's no charge for recycling.

Does Home Depot collect batteries?

In comparing the different retailer programs, Home Depot stands out for its long-term commitment to Call2Recycle (its original partner since 2001), its extensive network of collection sites (1,970 stores across the U.S.), and the sheer volume of batteries it collects.

What is a lithium ion battery used for?

Lithium Ion batteries (LI-ion) (rechargeable) Uses: laptops, other small electronics. Uses: smaller equipment and backup power supplies. Rechargeable Battery Recycling Corporation (RBRC), which provides the required recycling for most battery manufacturers, accepts SSLA batteries weighing up to 11 pounds. Uses: autos, boats, trucks.

Can you put batteries in the trash at Home Depot?

You can't take single-use batteries to Call2Recycle drop-off sites at The Home Depot. In most places, you can put alkaline batteries, such as AA, AAA and D batteries, in the trash. They can be carried out to the curb with the rest of your household garbage. Many landfills will also accept trash bags that contain alkaline batteries.

Can you recycle alkaline batteries at Home Depot?

Most places don't accept single-use alkaline batteries for recycling. You can't take single-use batteries to Call2Recycle drop-off sites at The Home Depot. In most places, you can put alkaline batteries, such as AA, AAA and D batteries, in the trash. They can be carried out to the curb with the rest of your household garbage.

Can lithium batteries be recycled?

The company claims it can recycle any lithium battery type for 30-40% less than mining new materials. Redwood Materials, founded by former Tesla CTO JB Straubel, is building a "closed-loop" battery recycling system in Nevada that can recover 95-98% of lithium, cobalt, copper, and nickel from battery packs.

The program is free to residents and accepts Lithium Ion (Li-ion), Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel-Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), and Nickel Zinc (Ni-ZN) as well as small lead-acid batteries.

Store the batteries in a cool, dry place until disposal. It's best to avoid extreme temperatures, since batteries can be reactive. Similarly, it's best to keep the batteries dry. Place your used lithium batteries in a pantry, cabinet, or closet. Take your battery to the collection site.
