

How many electrification projects are there in Madagascar?

Funded by ADER, implementation of rural electrification projects mainly depends on partnership with private operators. According to a diagnostic report of the MEM, ADER counted about 140 electrification projects from 2004 to 2012.

What type of Hydropower is used in Madagascar?

Large-scale hydropower. The exploitation of Madagascar's hydropower resource is made up of two types of hydropower plants: large-scale hydropower plants with an installed capacity of more than 25 MW and small-scale of hydropower plants with under 25 MW size of installed power, with two plants options namely storage capacity and run-of-river.

Why does Madagascar have a low rate of electricity?

Only less than 1% of this demand is supplied by other renewable energy sources. This high share of wood energy is explained by its accessibility and its low cost for the population. Madagascar has a low rate electricity access due to its high price and the insufficient quantity production. The national rate of electrification is only 4.7% only.
