It is the only planet in our solar system with liquid water on the surface. Earth is the biggest of the four terrestrial planets, i.e. Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars.

The Sun is like the big boss of our solar system. It holds a whopping 99.86% of the total weight of everything in our solar system! Imagine a pie chart of the solar system's weight - the Sun would be the entire pie, with

just a tiny sliver left for all the ...
