

## Hit chinese solar companies

Why are solar companies struggling in China?

Many of China's provinces are struggling to service their debts. Solar companies must also compete for government largesse with firms in other industries that are grappling with overcapacity as China's economy slows. More than a fifth of Chinese industrial firms were unprofitable last year, according to analysis by Rhodium, another consultancy.

Which Chinese solar companies have been hit the hardest?

The share prices of other Chinese solar giants, including Trina Solar, JA Solar and Jinko Power, have also been battered (see chart 2). Smaller companies have been hit even harder. Yana Hryshko of Wood Mackenzie explains that the big firms are typically diversified, helping them weather the collapse in solar prices. Others are not so lucky.

Is China's largest solar company evading American tariffs?

A year ago, the Biden administration accused one of China's largest solar manufacturers of evading American tariffs. Now the company is building a massive panel factory in Texas -- and it could receive more than \$1 billion in tax subsidies under President Joe Biden's signature climate law.

Are Europe and China winning a battle over the solar industry?

Europe and China's battle over the solar industry has been going on for two decades. Chinese solar-panel makers are winning with an unassailable lead: they now account for 80 per cent of global production capacity. But the cost of that victory is now looking too high. China dominates the solar panel sector's entire supply chain.

Why are Chinese solar companies destroying the US market?

Chinese solar firms have repeatedly shrunk output in existing hubs while building new factories in other countries, allowing them to sidestep tariffs and dominate the U.S. and global markets despite successive waves of U.S. tariffs over more than a decade designed to rein them in.

Can the US jump-start a solar industry without China?

The group includes Korea's Qcells, Swiss solar manufacturer Meyer Burger and First Solar. Calls for additional tariffs have prompted protests from renewable energy developers, who say the U.S. is unlikely to jump-start its solar industry and meet its climate goals without help from China.
