Silver oxide batteries are button cells commonly used in watches, toys, and calculators. Most jewelry stores will recycle the silver oxide battery when you bring your watch in to have the battery replaced. Otherwise, this battery type may be accepted at one of the Commonwealth's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events.

#2 - Cell Phones. Look at your cell phone. Most people have one and use it daily, but after a year or two, the phone is old and becoming obsolete. When it's time for an upgrade, some carriers allow you to trade in your cell phone for a newer model. That can make recycling the lithium-ion battery, metal, glass, and plastic easy to manage.

When it's time to get rid of the batteries, start by checking local ordinances. A few cities and towns will recycle any batteries for you if you just leave them in a plastic bag on top of your trashcan. About half of states have laws mandating specific disposal methods for consumers.
