It is critical that these temperatures be maintained through warehousing, distribution, delivery and storage. The cooler refrigerated milk is kept, the longer it lasts and the safer it is. As the product is allowed to warm, the bacteria grow more rapidly. Properly refrigerated, milk can withstand about two weeks" storage.

Freezing milk extends its usable life significantly. For long-term storage, milk can be frozen for up to 12 months, with the optimal quality retained if used within 6 months.
