What is inkstone in Chinese art?

Inkstone is Chinese art's mixing palette for ink. In particular the inks are kept in the form of a inkstick which is rubbed on the stone and mixed with water to make liquid ink.

What are inkstones used for?

Inkstones are much more than just practical items for ink grinding. There are two main types; one for everyday use and another for decorative or collecting purposes. In ancient China beautifully carved and inscribed inkstones made by famous artists were often presented as tribute or gift from one ruler to another.

What does inkstone look like?

Ink sticks have been a very practical way of conserving and transporting ink. The ink is obtained by rubbing the ink stick, called &quot;Sumi&quot;, upon the surface of a stone vessel called &quot;Suzuri&quot;. Production of ink sticks dates back to the 8th Century. Suzuka City and Nara City are both well known for the production of ink sticks.

To avoid wasting money and ensure your cartridges are ready to use, here are some simple tips on how to store printer ink cartridges correctly. 1. Store In A Cool, Dry Place. Keep your ink cartridges in a cool, dry place away from sunlight. Sunlight can dry out the ink, so it's best to put them in a drawer or cupboard.

If an ink stone is too rough it can damage the very delicate hairs of the brush, because you use the surface of the ink stone to bring the tip of the brush into the right shape or to remove the excess ink. In short, an ink stone should be neither too hard nor too soft. As I said, an ink stone must also have the right texture or porousness.
