Where can I recycle a battery?

Visit www.Earth911.org or call 1-800-CLEANUP to learn about local battery recycling opportunities. All you need is your zip code. Often called 'flashlight batteries,' alkaline batteries are usually single use batteries in 9 volt, C, D, AA and AAA. Some alkaline batteries are rechargeable.

Where can I recycle SSLA batteries?

Uses: smaller equipment and backup power supplies. Rechargeable Battery Recycling Corporation(RBRC), which provides the required recycling for most battery manufacturers, accepts SSLA batteries weighing up to 11 pounds. Uses: autos, boats, trucks. Retailers are required to take back for recycling as trade-ins for new batteries.

Are discharged LiPo batteries safe?

While some hobbyists claim that throwing discharged LiPo batteries into your trash is safe,hazardous materials could still leak out when the trash is compacted. Using a professional recycling service ensures they're safely taken apart and disposed of.

Lithium-ion batteries can be recycled at the Miami County Recycling Center at no cost. The terminals must be taped with electical or packing tape. Some local retailers will accept these ...



For proper disposal, rechargeable batteries may be brought to any of the County"s three drop-off facilities to be recycled. Many retailers also accept these items for recycling; a list of local drop-off sites can be found at mdrecycles or on the Call2Recycle website. As an extra precaution, you may place your batteries in a flame-retardant bag or bucket for transport.

Batteries contain lead and sulfuric acid, which are dangerous to marine life. Giving batteries to recycling companies is a great way of battery disposal. Disposing of any type of battery safely is a must for any responsible citizen. However, recycling batteries is better for the environment.

First and foremost: do not place batteries in your recycling bin or cart. Batteries cannot be recycled locally in this way, and they create a fire hazard in recycling trucks and facilities. Take your batteries to one of the following locations to be properly disposed of. Be sure to place them in a clear, sealable bag.

Non-leaking batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Place your batteries in the plastic bags provided and drop them in the bin. There is no charge for recycling. The Impact of Recycling. In 2022, The Home Depot recycled 180,000 lead-acid batteries. The same year, we recycled 1,300,000 pounds of rechargeable batteries.

Once fully discharged, a LiPo can be safely discarded in regular trash, but recycling is the preferred option. Ask your local hobby store if it accepts LiPos for recycling. If it doesn't, visit the website call2recycle to find out where you can drop off your LiPo pack.
