Situated in the South African town of Bokpoort in the Northern Cape province, the 50 MW CSP plant, with an output capacity of 200 GWh per year, uses a 1.3 GWh molten salt energy storage facility, capable of providing approximately 9.3 hours of thermal energy storage, to serve up to 21,000 households while offsetting 230,000 tons of CO2 per year.

The project is part of Mozambique"s plan to deploy 200MW of renewable energy over a five-year period, and is the third large-scale solar plant in Mozambique. Filipe Nyusi, president of Mozambique, said at an inauguration ceremony: "The Cuamba solar and storage plant will provide greater energy security and stability in this region of ...

It marked another milestone for Globeleq and Mozambique, as it was the first IPP to integrate a utility-scale energy storage system. A Mozambique Renewable Energy Atlas was published in 2014 in order to map the potential of the renewable resources in Mozambique, namely hydropower, solar, wind, biomass, wave energy and geothermal. The total potential for generating electricity from renewable resources is over 23,000GW, most of which comes from solar energy.

EDM and Mozambique support the development of renewable energy projects, having launched public tenders for solar and wind projects, the country is also exploring battery storage solutions. The largest power generation plant in the country is the Cahora Bassa hydro dam, operated by the government owned Hidroeléctrica de Cahora Bassa (HCB).

The African Development Bank (AfDB) has approved a grant of a grant of US\$2.5 million to the government of Mozambique for feasibility studies into a floating solar PV farm and up to 10 energy storage systems.

The goal is to add 200 MW in combined capacity with at least 100 MW of battery energy storage supported by subsidies. Participants are competing for EUR 55 million. Maximum support per plant is EUR 549,000 per MW, excluding value-added tax, of the storage unit so operating power.
