Does SimpliSafe have a rechargeable battery?

SimpliSafe's base station is unique in that although it can still be connected to a power outlet, in the event of power failure, it can switch to its in-built rechargeable battery to keep the system running. According to SimpliSafe, the rechargeable battery can power the system for up to 24 hours.

How does SimpliSafe protect you during a power outage?

SimpliSafe keeps you protected 24/7! In the event of a power outage, your SimpliSafe Base Station is equipped with a backup rechargeable battery supply that will keep your Base Station powered for up to 24 hrs. It also features a cellular module that operates on a cellular network instead of Wi-Fi.

Can you change a SimpliSafe battery before a power outage?

In conclusion, unlike most home security system devices, SimpliSafe offers users the ability to extend their devices' up-time by using additional backup battery power. Also, changing a SimpliSafe battery is easy and requires no special installation skills. But what if you can't change out the batteries in time before an outage?

To charge your battery, you'll need a USB-supported power brick that supports 5V, 7.5W+, 1.5A+ charging. Using the supplied cable, plug it into the power brick and the camera and charge your battery. To fully charge your battery, it can take up to 5 hours.

Add Wi-Fi as a Backup Connection Your SimpliSafe system automatically uses cellular to connect to the monitoring services (assuming you pay for that plan), but if the SimpliSafe ever loses the cellular signal, it can use Wi-Fi as a backup connection. Just go into System Settings and select the 'WiFi' entry.

Just to clarify, power outage in itself will not cause the monitoring service to dispatch police. However, if the system is triggered into an alarm state when the mains power is off/disconnected, the normal monitoring/dispatch process still works so long as there is cellular service and the backup batteries in the base still have juice left.

Unplug your Base Station from power by removing the power cable from the bottom of it. Use a Philips head screwdriver to remove the security screw, underneath where the power cable was. Next, remove the battery cover from the bottom of the Base Station to expose the batteries. Remove the old batteries
