Is South Carolina a good place for solar energy?

South Carolina's sunny weather and long summers make it ideal for solar energy. According to the Solar Energy Industries Association (SEIA), the Palmetto State has invested nearly \$3 billion in solar as of December 2022, and 2.85% of its electricity comes from solar panels.

The South Carolina Department of Natural Resources' (SCDNR) solar siting tool compares the sensitivity of lands to impacts from large-scale solar projects and their suitability for solar development.

How do I choose the best solar company in South Carolina?

The best way to determine the best solar company near you in South Carolina is to sort through customer experiences and then talk to a representative. Ensure that the company is certified by the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP). Whenever possible, opt for a BBB-accredited name and aim for an A+ rating.

In South Carolina, only those companies approved to operate by the SC Office of Regulatory Staff (ORS) may lease solar systems. Finally, if you have too much shade, don't want to make a long-term commitment, don't own your residence, or simply don't want the hassle, you will be able to purchase a share in a community solar
