One of the most innovative energy storage system, which has been proposed as an alternative to PHS, is Gravity energy storage (GES) technology. This latter system was first proposed by Heindl under the name of "Hydraulic Rock". The functioning of this system depends on the hydraulic lifting of an extremely heavy piston using pressurized water.

This new energy storage concept is being advanced by a Californian/Swiss startup company called Energy Vault as a solution to renewable energy's intermittency problem. The towers would store electricity generated by renewables when their output is high in windy, sunny conditions and release energy back to the grid when production falls as ...

The concept is similar to other gravity energy storage technologies, but Swinnerton believes the use of old mine shafts, rather than purpose-built tall towers, will be his competitive advantage.
