The energy accumulation principle is based on the transformation of primary energy into a form that is easier to accumulate and store as well as its further transformation into a customer-acceptable form (Figure 2). The accumulation process may consist of sequential transformation elements or of direct accumulation without transformation, for ...

The pyramid of energy is a graphical representation that shows energy accumulation patterns at different trophic levels in an ecosystem. The energy flow moves from the bottom to up through the layers of the energy pyramid. Energy is higher at the bottom of the pyramid but gradually reduced as energy is used up by the organism at each level.

The rate of accumulation of energy will not be constant unless it is zero (otherwise every reactor in the world would either blow up from excessive mass and energy buildup or would cease operating because all of the reactants and products would be drained out). Recall that if the accumulation reaches zero, the system is at steady state.
