NOTE: As of January 1, 2024, batteries may no longer be thrown in the garbage in areas served by Seattle Public Utilities. Please follow the guidance on this page and take any batteries for disposal to a hazardous waste collection facility, arrange for a special item pick-up through Seattle Public Utilities, or work with a local battery recycling organization.

All consumer single use or rechargeable batteries weighing less than 5 kg each can be recycled. These include batteries used to power cordless tools, mobile and cordless phones, laptop computers, digital cameras, flashlights, watches and other products. Why should I recycle? Batteries contain a number of heavy metals and toxic chemicals.

Making sure these smaller lithium-ion batteries get collected and recycled will support the growing battery recycling industry in the U.S. Sending end-of-life batteries for recycling also keeps them out of the household garbage and recycling systems, where they can start fires and endanger workers and nearby communities.

The importance of recycling a laptop battery, particularly lithium-ion batteries, is two-fold. The first is the reduction of e-waste. Lithium is an important mineral and one that takes significant effort to mine.

If you want to store your batteries with the care of a scientist, Dickerson says, one of the safest options is to hold on to the original packing and reuse it to house the spent batteries. That's what he does. "You can use a permanent marker to mark the old batteries so you don't get them confused with the new ones," he says.

Laptop Battery Express sends the collected laptop batteries to a battery recycling facility for processing. A thermal recovery process reclaims the metals (nickel, iron, cadmium, lead and cobalt) from the laptop batteries and prepares them for use in new products such as new notebook computer batteries and stainless steel.
