TES can have direct thermal energy as input, like waste heat, waste cold and solar thermal energy, but also electricity, after being converted to heat or cold, can be considered as TES energy source.

SH-TES efficiency may vary (50-90%) mainly due to thermal leakage and thermal isolation issues.
